Southwell Minster and Corby Glen  
Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> August 2019  
Guided tours with the Revd Dr Lynne Broughton**

The Cathedral and Parish Church of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Southwell, generally known as Southwell Minster, achieved Cathedral status in 1884 and now serves the Diocese of Southwell and Nottingham. A major church building mainly of the twelfth and thirteenth centuries, it would be celebrated even if it were not for the superb naturalistic leaf carvings in the Chapter House and vestibule, which merited an entire monograph by Nikolaus Pevsner, *The Leaves of Southwell*, published by Penguin in 1945.

St John Evangelist Corby Glen is a parish church of the thirteenth century and later, with extensive medieval wall paintings.
